Through civic learning, students build the knowledge, skills, and dispositions needed to be civically engaged and participate responsibly and effectively in democratic society.

The conference invites educators, scholars, and community partners to share innovative practices, research, and classroom experiences that support critical thinking, democratic engagement, culturally responsive teaching, and student inquiry. Together, we will explore how social studies education can equip students to become informed consumers of information, thoughtful collaborators, and active participants in civic life.
